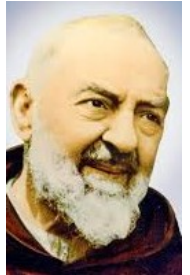
PETER GUY WRITES : UPCOMING EVENTS

PADRE PIO : was an Italian peasant who joined the Capuchin friars at age 15 and took the name of "Pio". He became a priest in 1910. Padre Pio became internationally famous, known for his piety, charity and the quality of his preaching. He famously advised, "Pray, hope and don't worry." Padre Pio died on September 23, 1968. His funeral was attended by over 100,000 people. Pope John Paul II recognized Padre Pio as a saint on June 16, 2002. His feast day is September 23. Mass will be here that day at 10.0 am.
