SAINTS OF THE WEEK :

Francis de Sales, 1567 – 1622 was a Bishop of Geneva who became noted for his deep faith and his gentleness. He is known also for his writings on the topic of spiritual direction and spiritual formation, particularly the *Introduction to the Devout Life*. Feast Day this Tuesday.

St Paul the Apostle also known by his native name Saul of Tarsus was an apostle who taught the gospel of the Christ to the first century world. Feast of his Conversion this Wednesday

SS Timothy & Titus : close companions of the Apostle Paul and bishops of the Catholic Church in its earliest days. Both men received letters from St. Paul, which are included in the New Testament. Joint Feast Day this Thursday.

St Thomas Aquinas : 1225-1274 Italian Dominican friar, priest, and Doctor of the Church. He was an immensely influential philosopher, theologian, and is also known as the *Doctor Angelicus—The Angelic Doctor*. Feast Day this Saturday.
