THIS SUNDAY: CORPUS ET SANGUIS CHRISTI

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST this year, following the recent changes, will be celebrated this **Sunday, 18 June**.

On this day, when we celebrate the gift to us of the Blessed Sacrament in the Sacrifice of the Mass, we renew our devotion to our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.

DAY FOR LIFE Day for Life is also kept on this Sunday

Day for Life is the day in the Church's year dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The Church teaches that life should be protected and nurtured from conception to natural death.

Day for Life is celebrated annually by the Catholic Church in Ireland, Scotland, England and Wales. **Information and prayer sheets are available.**

This year's Day for Life is particularly significant as it is **50 years since the 1967 Abortion Act was passed in England, Scotland and Wales.**

The second collection on this day assists the work of the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other life-related activities supported by the Church.

SOLEMNITY OF ST PETER AND ST PAUL, APOSTLES

On **Thursday 29 June** we shall keep the **Holy Day of Obligation and Solemnity of the Apostles, Peter and Paul** and celebrate our spiritual links with our Holy Father, Pope Francis and the life of the Church in Rome.
