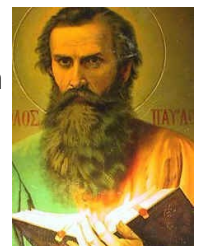
### *SS Timothy & Titus*

Timothy was Bishop of Ephesus and went with St Paul on his missionary journeys. He died as a martyr in about 97AD



Titus was also a friend of St Paul who made his Bishop of Crete. Both Timothy & Titus received letters from St Paul which are counted among the books of the New Testament.

**Conversion of St Paul** The conversion of Paul the Apostle, was, according to the New Testament, an event in the life of Paul the Apostle that led him to cease persecuting early Christians and to become a follower of Jesus. It is normally dated to AD 33-36
