Say NO to decriminalising abortion.

Decriminalising abortion would strip from unborn children any remaining legal protection from abortion. Abortion should remain a criminal offence if performed outside the terms of the 1967 Abortion Act. The Act is bad law, but keeping abortion within the law does offer some safeguards for mothers and unborn babies. Decriminalising abortion would mean vulnerable pregnant women buying online abortion pills and taking them with no medical supervision. It will mean abortion up to birth for any reason.
