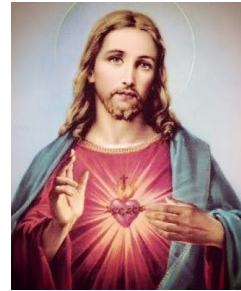

Devotion to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** has its roots all the way back to the time of the Apostles, and arguably even before this in the Song of Songs penned by Solomon. St. John the Evangelist is the Apostle associated with the Sacred Heart devotion because, one, he was known as the disciple whom Jesus loved; two, he was called the "Apostle of Love" due to the theme of love repeated in his Gospel and epistles; and three, because he had the special privilege of reclining on the chest of Jesus at the Last Supper. (the significance of which will be discussed below).

On June 11, 1899, by order of Pope Leo XIII, all mankind was solemnly consecrated to His Sacred Heart. Pope Leo XIII called this event "the great act" of his pontificate.
