The new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which came into force at the end of May entails some changes as to how the diocese and parish store personal data, the consent required to store and share that data, and our obligations regarding its protection. For example, we cannot respond to a request for a baptism certificate for anyone over the age of 12, except from the baptised individual, or if we are provided with proof of consent from the individual; this consent cannot be presumed (e.g., if the request is made by a parent), but must be explicit.
