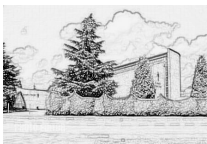


ST JOSEPH'S, WHITNASH

Pastimes is hosting a group from St George's Church in Worcester on **Tuesday 17 July**. All are invited to the hall after Mass to welcome our visitors and partake of a **light lunch**.

Aid to the Church in Need: Dee Thomas from ACN will be speaking at **Our Lady's** Masses next weekend (21 & 22 July). There will be an opportunity to purchase cards, prayer cards, books, rosaries and religious artefacts.

Comboni Missionaries' Appeal: One of the Verona Fathers will be visiting **St Peter's** next weekend and will be making a Mission Appeal at both Masses.

Fr David Cullen is a White Father in Zambia, regularly supported by SPAN. At last week's **SPAN meeting** he spoke about his work.

There are regular Masses for 500 at a Zambian girls' school; hospital chaplaincy; and prison chaplaincy for a prison with more than 1,000 inmates of which 50 are women, some with babies. They have rescued 15 prostitutes – four of them are now in school and older ones have been helped to set up small businesses (which cost from just £30.00).
