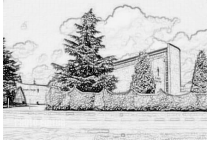


ST JOSEPH'S, WHITNASH

Dear Parishioners,

Aid to the Church in Need:

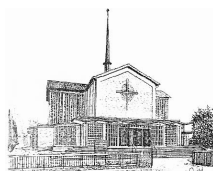
