Princethorpe War Memorial

We have been successful in our bid for funding for the War Memorial to the amount of 75% of the cost i.e. £3750.00. Plans are in place to re-dedicate the restored memorial on Sunday 11 November 2018 at 11.00am after the **10.00am Mass** - note earlier Mass time. **Please put that date and time in your diaries.** Work has begun last week. A press release has been issued in connection with this event.
