Plans are in place to re-dedicate the restored memorial on Sunday 11 November 2018 at 11.00am after the **10.00am Mass** - note earlier Mass time. **Please put that date and time in your diaries.** Work has begun with the removal of the body of Jesus, (which is cast iron, this will be cleaned and re-enameled), the rotten oak cross and the revealing of a badly corroded steel support for the cross.
