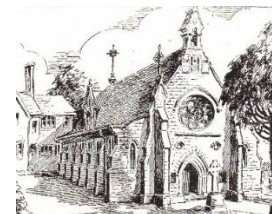

- **A YEAR FOR PRIESTS 2018-2019.** On the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart 2018, there began a year of thanksgiving, prayer and celebration for the priests of the Archdiocese of Birmingham. This is to prepare for a national celebration of priesthood to coincide with the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart in Westminster Cathedral in 2019. We are all invited to share in prayer and reflection on the

meaning and importance of the priesthood in the life of the church and to encourage vocations to the church.

- **ADOREMUS 2018** - Marys Meals. One of the presentations given on the Saturday was from Magnus MacFarlane-Barrow. Mary's Meals is a movement to set up school feeding projects in places where poverty and hunger prevent children from gaining an education. The education they receive is their best hope of escaping poverty in later life. It all grew from a simple response to the suffering of the refugees caught up in the horror of the Balkans war in 1992. It began with a local appeal for food and blankets, that Magnus and Fergus MacFarlane-Barrow drove out to Medjugorje for the refugees that had gathered there. What was supposed to be a one-off aid project has now developed into Marys Meals a charity that now is providing 1.25 million children with a daily life-transforming meal in school each day.
