Today is Sea Sunday, when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea, often in dangerous conditions, around our shores and throughout the world. Without them we would not have most of the items we buy in the shops. The second collection will be for Stella

Maris, Apostleship of the Sea, the official welfare agency of the Catholic Church, which provides practical and spiritual support to seafarers visiting our ports.

Stella Maris has chaplains and volunteers in ports all over the world and visits over 70,000 ships every year. They help (usually) men who may be separated from their families for months, some of them stranded in foreign countries without pay or means of support, and whose rights and dignity are often overlooked. Some may be sick or have been injured in accidents onboard ship, and there are those who are ill-treated and frightened. This help is offered regardless of race or religion, and Catholic seafarers are also supported in their faith.
