**Defibrillator at Wappenbury**

A defibrillator has been installed in the house porch at St Anne's Wappenbury. It is available all day and every day. You don't need to be trained to use a defibrillator - anyone can use it. There are clear instructions on how to attach the defibrillator pads. It then assesses the heart rhythm and will only instruct you to deliver a shock if it's needed. You cannot deliver a shock accidentally; the defibrillator will only deliver a shock if it is needed.
