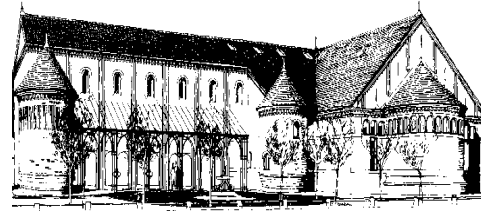

## **ST JOHN HENRY NEWMAN, PRIEST**

On **Sunday 13 October** Blessed John Henry Newman will be canonised by Pope Francis, along with four other ‘Blesseds’. Newman (1801-90) is a man of great significance in the life of the Church and of this country. He shows us the path of journeying with God from his first real awareness of God at the age of 16 through study, prayer and service. Along with others he sought to revive and enrich the life of the Church of England through what became known as the Oxford Movement. His experiences led him to reception into the Catholic Church in 1846. As a Catholic priest he founded the Oratories in London and Birmingham. His writings became so influential in the Church – they formed much of the thinking of the Second Vatican Council. Newman always searched for the ‘Kindly Light’ of Christ in all he did.
