This phrase sprang to mind as I was looking at some of the pictures of Blessed John Henry Newman who is made a Saint by Pope Francis in Rome today (Sunday 13 October). Blessed John Henry Newman is often seen wearing the red cassock of a Cardinal which might make us think he was a high-ranking member of the Curia. Nothing could be further from the truth.

Blessed John Henry Newman was an Oratorian priest living in community at St Philip's along the Hagley Road. His ministry was to the ordinary folk of Birmingham where he was much loved for his holiness and kindness – it is said 15,000 people lined the streets as his hearse passed by.

He was an intellectual giant. The depth of his thought and writings were said to have influenced the thinking of the Bishops at the Second Vatican Council.

I hope that we will be able to learn more about our newest English Saint. Please take home the special prayer cards. May the story of Saint John Henry Newman be an inspiration and example to us all.
