Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we turn the clocks back but only by one hour. Imagine being able to turn the clocks back a little further. Would we choose the hot weather of July; or further still, a chance to put right something we got wrong? Putting the clocks back an hour will not change our past but does affect our future.

Looking back to last weekend I'd like to thank all who arranged, prepared and participated in our wider parish events: Jumble Sale, Just Desserts, and the Sacrament of the Sick: Mass of Anointing. All these events help us to get to know each other a little better. Our Eucharistic community is blessed at Mass when we receive Holy Communion but it is achieved through communion with each other.

The parish family is what is being referred to by St Paul when he speaks about the body working together in unity. Each part has a purpose and is dependent on each other. Together the parish family is blessed by God to achieve the Mission of the Church. One aspect which characterises the parish family is the care we show for all are in need.
