THE WORD THIS WEEK

Remembrance Sunday last week reminds us that war is never far away even now. A sense of foreboding has gripped many people since 2001, the rise of Isis, and so on. It isn't just terrorism; it is climate change, possible environmental disaster or some new and unknown disease; life seems very frail, and the Gospel today thus chimes in with many of our anxieties. Yet Jesus says 'Do not be frightened ... the end is not soon.' We are looking at it from the wrong end entirely. The message is not *we're all doomed* but *Christ will come again*. This Sunday is a foretaste of Advent.
