

St. Anthony, called the 'Patriarch of Monks' is celebrated on the day of his death, 17 January, in what was one of the most heartfelt celebrations in the rural communities, deeply connected with pre-Christian cults and traditions. Actually, Anthony had little or nothing to do with the rural world: indeed, he was a hermit and among the most rigorous ascetics in the history of early Christianity, the founder of Christian monasticism and the first abbot. He died aged 105.
