St Blaise, (Patron Saint of throat illnesses):

was raised as a Christian in a rich family, he became a Bishop. In a vision, God appeared to him and told

him to flee. To avoid persecution he lived in the hills with sick animals and cared for them. He was later captured and while in prison he cured a boy who was choking on a fish bone. He was ordered to be killed by not renouncing the Faith and Love of God. There is a St Blaise's Well in Kent which is believed to have medicinal properties. A blessing of the throats ceremony is held every February 3rd in St Etheldreda's Church London and Balve, Germany.
