Beatification of MSC priests and their lay associates

Below is a communication from the Spanish Provincial of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart, received last week. The ten to be beatified were killed in the violence in Guatemala in the 1980s.

"I announce joyful news! That our brothers: José María Gran, Faustino Villanueva and Juan Alonso, have been recognised by Pope Francis as martyrs of the faith (They gave their lives in the mission of Guatemala).

Seven lay persons will also be beatified along with them.

We hope that in a few months the date and place of the solemn proclamation of their status as Blessed Martyrs will be determined.
