Parishioners' Reflections Matthew 17:1-9 Margot O'Rourke

Each year the feast of the Transfiguration is celebrated on 6 Aug. Each Lent the transfiguration account appears as a Sunday Gospel reading. Reflecting on the experience of the transfiguration can help us understand the totally opposite side to that which the prophet Isaiah (52:14) speaks of on Good Friday. 'So disfigured did he look, he looked no longer human'. The transfiguration is a foretaste of Jesus' resurrection, eternal life and the transforming power of the cross into a symbol of grace. Perhaps the challenge is reflecting on the vertical beam of the cross as our relationship between God and us, while the horizontal beam is our relationship between us and others. Lord we ask, by encountering you in both the scriptures and Eucharist our brokenness and pain are transfigured and we too can say, it is wonderful to be here.
