

Gift Aid Thank you for all your kind donations via the new parish Paypal button on the website. About 50% of these are gift aid so the church receives 25% extra from the government for everything you have given. Just to clarify the gift aid rules, you no longer have to promise a regular payment. Your payment can be one-off, two-off, three-off or anything. If any of the remaining 50% are taxpayers, please do consider becoming a gift aider. You just have to sign a short form which can be downloaded from the website or which the office can email to you. It can be back dated to cover your donation.

A second point about gift aid is that it is personal to you. 8 of our recent donations have come from wives/ husbands of people who gift aid. The rules unfortunately do not let them donate on their spouse's behalf. If this is you therefore, and you pay tax, do complete your own gift aid form from the church office.

St Antony of Padua 1195?-1231

St Antony was first of all an Augustinian monk, but he was so impressed by the martyrdom of five Franciscans who had been spreading the faith in Morocco that he became a Franciscan friar himself, so that he could preach the gospel in Africa too. Illness obliged him to leave Morocco, and a storm then drove his ship to Sicily, so that he found himself taking part in the General Chapter of the Franciscans in 1221, where he met St Francis of Assisi himself. His preaching career then took him to northern Italy and southern France, then a stronghold of the Albigensian heresy. Later he returned to Italy, to Padua, where he was an outstanding preacher and the first Franciscan theologian. His sermons are full of gentleness, but he reproved the wicked with fearless severity – especially backsliding clergy and the oppressors of the weak. His shrine is a centre of pilgrimage, and he is also the patron saint of the lost and found.
