Church Reopening for Mass. Next Weekend Saturday 15th August Sunday 16th August

We will be reopening our church for Public Mass from next weekend the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary our Parish Co patron. Many thanks to all the volunteers who have worked hard for this.

I am sure you will all rejoice with me that we are able to resume our worship at Our Lady and St Benedict's.

We have had to introduce some changes in line with the Government's Covid advice. The main points are that we will be only using our Church. Everyone will be expected to wear a face mask unless medically exempt. We will be following social distancing guidelines. You must maintain a 1m+ distance from others not in your family or social bubble. This will equate to two seats on a row. The numbers are limited.

The doors will open 20 minutes before mass to allow the congregation in and to settle before mass. Please wait outside if there is queue until the Stewards call you in. The Steward will direct you to the first available seat. Please respect others at prayer while in the church.

It is recommended as part of The Government's Track and Trace that all attending leave their name and phone number please bring a piece of paper with your family name phone number and date., or use the form sent in our email. The details will be kept by the parish and destroyed after 21 days.

If you or your family have the symptoms of COVID 19 please do not come to the church

Theme: Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

This Sunday's Story in Matthew follows on from the feeding of the five thousand last week. It shows Jesus revealing more of himself to his apostles.

After the crowd had gone Jesus sent the apostles across the lake while he went up to the hills to Pray. Very Early in the Morning the apostles were hit by a storm while out on the lake, Jesus further revealed himself to the apostles by walking on the water through the storm towards them. Telling them not to be afraid. Peter started out then lost confidence Jesus reached out to save him.

This is not just a story about a miracle at sea, but it is both a strong statement about Jesus and about the future of the disciples.

Visitor Guidelines for Mass @ Our Lady and St Benedict's

The Church will be open for around 20 minutes before mass

If there is a queue at the doorway, please wait for it to clear.

For everyone's peace of mind and safety, please follow the guidelines below. Note there are no toilet facilities available.

- Please follow the directions of the stewards. Keep to the social distancing guidelines.
- Please do not visit if you or your family have Covid 19 symptoms.
- Enter through the Porch keep left and sanitise your hands-on arrival. You should wear a face covering unless you are medically exempt.
- The area inside the main door near the baptism font and piety stall is reserved for the wardens. Please carry on through to main body of Church
- Follow the arrows round the church:
 - Through porch and into the body of the church Keep left, towards side chapel entrance. You will be directed to a seat by a steward
 - across the front of the Altar and Sanctuary
 - leave via the right-side isle (Statue of St Benedict side) and right-side exit
- Please leave 2 seats per row clear between social and family groups.
- Only sit where there is a green card, turning it over when you leave (so that it is red).
- If you wish to offer votive candles, please leave a candle in the stand. The steward will light it do not try to light off another candle.
- Sanitise hands on departure
- Do not enter the Sanctuary, side Chapel or Choir loft unless directed by a steward.
- The piety stall and cards are closed off.
- Observe any requests from stewards if they ask you to move.
- Can all family member remain in their seat until they are called forward for Communion?
- At the end of Mass please leave as soon as possible in an orderly manner under the direction of the Stewards

Our Lady and St Benedict's Church Track and Trace Compliance

In line with guidance issued by the Department for Health and Social Care, we are collecting details of those who attend our church. We will keep your details safely and in compliance with GDPR legislation for 21 days before securely disposing of or deleting them.
