THE WORD THIS WEEK

How does God reveal himself to us? Most of the time, in precisely the way we do not expect! This is what happened to Elijah: we expect God - all-powerful, almighty - to appear in dramatic effects of nature; but no, God is in a gentle breeze. Similarly in the Gospel: the disciples do not expect



Jesus to come towards them walking on the lake - but he does. And when God is revealed in the unexpected, he gives courage and strength: Elijah was afraid when he went to Horeb, but was strengthened by his encounter with God to continue his mission; in the same way the disciples are given courage and faith by the Lord who walks to them on the waters.

GENERAL NOTICES

Assumption: Mass at Warwick Racecourse!
Sun 16 Aug at 11am. It will be the only Mass for both our parishes that weekend. There will be free parking. Please bring a folding chair and refreshments for afterwards.

Live streaming: is now in place at St Mary's. Those who sit at the front are visible as are those who go up to receive Holy Communion. Please let Fr Patrick know if you wish to make other arrangements for receiving Holy Communion.



Stewarding: Public Mass can take place depending on the availability of stewards. There has to be 2 stewards on duty for Mass to be able to go ahead.

Capacity: St Mary's 30, St Charles 20. From the start of September we will have a booking system in place for both churches for Sunday Mass.

When visiting the church

Wash your hands beforehand.

Wear a mask

Use the sanitizer provided when entering & leaving the church.

Please be directed by the stewards.

Keep apart from people you don't live with.

Follow the one-way system.

Don't touch surfaces except where you sit.

The toilets are out of use.

Ask one of the stewards if you need to use the side entrance at St Mary Immaculate.

If you arrive and the church isn't open, we apologise for the inconvenience in advance.

Changes to the celebration of Mass:

In the Church's guidelines, the overriding principle is brevity (3-minute Sunday homily, no weekday homily, no bidding prayers, singing or sign of peace & no gathering afterwards). There is **no Sunday obligation**. **Masks** will be required for Mass due to social distancing being more difficult.

Confessions at St Mary's will be in the chapel where the statue of the Sacred Heart is. For Covid & Safeguarding reasons.
