The point is that all of us are gifted in varying ways and degrees: none of us should begrudge anyone else their talents, for fear that we overlook our own. We work wisely and well, looking forward to the master's return, when we can hand over to him not just what he gave us, but also the fruits that our labours have gained.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### St Hilda of Whitby: 614 – 680

Hilda was born in Northumbria and baptised by St Paulinus of York. As the abbess of Whitby – a monastery for both men and women – she led one of the most important religious centres in the Anglo-Saxon world. She convened the Synod of Whitby in 664 which decided how the date Easter should be calculated
