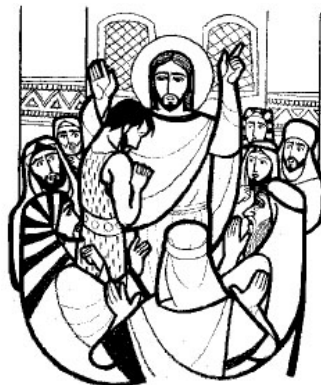

THE WORD THIS WEEK

Listening to God's voice is the message today. The first two readings have the word 'Listen'. If we don't, how will we know when God is speaking and not an unclean spirit? Whatever Jesus said in the synagogue at Capernaum that day (the foundations of which can be seen in the photo), it was enough to make a deep impression. The Gospels suggest there was an expectation of the Messiah, or of a 'prophet' foretold by Moses, who would speak in God's name and be listened to. Do we hear God's voice today, at this very Mass? Yes we do. Christ is really present in the words of Scripture proclaimed, including the Antiphons and Psalm response: *Harden not your hearts.*

St Blaise

According to tradition, Blaise was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia and was martyred under Licinius in the early fourth century. Devotion to him spread throughout the Eastern and Western Churches during the Middle Ages due to many cures attributed to him. He is particularly invoked for disorders of the throat.
