THE WORD THIS WEEK This week, in our journey through the Old Testament, we reach Covenant Number 3 - the Covenant with Moses at Sinai. The Ten Commandments form our side of the agreement with God - if we stick to these rules and commands, then we are truly God's people, and he is truly our God. If we ignore them, or break them, then we break the Covenant or relationship. The Temple was, for the people of Israel, the place that guaranteed the permanence of this Covenant - God dwelling with man. Jesus alerts us to the new Temple - himself - since he is the core of the New Covenant, God and Man in perfect unity. Only by the destruction of this new Temple, in his death, will he rise again as an eternal Temple, and the eternal guarantee of the New Covenant which we enjoy.

Roman Station Churches San Lorenzo fuori le Mura *Third Sunday of Lent*



The Papal Basilica of St Lawrence outside the Walls is a minor basilica & parish church. It is one of the 7 Pilgrim Churches of Rome and one of the 5 former "patriarchal basilicas", each of which was assigned to the care of a Latin Church patriarchate. The Basilica was assigned to the Patriarchate of Jerusalem. The Basilica is the shrine of the tomb of St Lawrence, one of the first seven deacons of Rome who was martyred in 258. Other saints including Bl. Pope Pius IX are buried at the Basilica, which is the centre of a large and ancient burial complex.
