THE WORD THIS WEEK

In the weeks of Lent so far we have followed God's work of salvation: we have seen the Covenants he established with Noah, Abraham, Moses and the people of Israel after the return from Babylon. Now we come to one of the most significant parts of the Old Testament: the promise of a new Covenant, which will be different from all those that went before. This Covenant will see God and Man living more closely together. For the ratification of a Covenant, something was always sacrificed as a sign of the new relationship – normally man would offer some animal offering to God. But the New Covenant will be ratified not with the death of sheep or bull, but by the death of Jesus Christ, God and Man. In this perfect sacrifice is the source of our eternal salvation.

Roman Station Churches

Santo Stefano Rotondo *Friday of the 5th week of Lent*



Built on top of the remains of a 2nd-century Mithraic temple (currently being excavated), the church was built in the 5th century AD to hold the body of St Stephen, which just had been brought to Rome from the Holy Land. The church's architecture is particularly unusual. As Rome's first circular church, it was modelled after Jerusalem's Church of the Holy Sepulchre.
