## Roman Station Churches

### Santa Prassede (St Praxedes) Monday of Holy Week

S. Prassede is an ancient basilica and the most important example of Byzantine art in Rome. The church as we see it now was built in 817 AD commissioned by Pope Paschal I, but a church already existed here in the 5th century and was possibly built on an even older shrine, dating back to 150. What makes this church special are the ancient mosaics that decorate its apse and side chapels, which are among the most beautiful in Rome.
