Defibrillator at Wappenbury

A defibrillator has been installed in the house porch at St Anne's Wappenbury. It is available all day and every day. The code to access the defibrillator has been given to a selected number of people whose names and contact numbers will be made public in due course. In the meantime the porch is unlocked all day.

'You don't need to be trained to use a defibrillator – anyone can use it. There are clear instructions on how to attach the defibrillator pads. It then assesses the heart rhythm and will only instruct you to deliver a shock if it's needed. You cannot deliver a shock accidentally, the defibrillator will only deliver a shock if it is needed.
